PRINCIPLES UNDERPINNING DRESS CODE

- Parents are encouraged to dress their children according to the school dress code at all times.
- Dress code:
 - Promotes school pride
 - Is reasonably priced
 - Maintains a focus on teaching and learning
 - Is practical
 - Promotes physical activity

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

- The Riverton Primary School Dress Code is as follows:
 - Navy shorts
 - Navy polo top, with or without Riverton Primary School logo
 - Navy windcheater, rugby top or polar fleece, with or without logo
 - Navy track pants or microfibre pants
 - Navy and white summer dress
 - Navy broadbrim or legionaries style hat – must be worn at all times in line with the SunSmart policy when outside as we are a SunSmart school
 - Suitable footwear (not thongs)
 - Students with shoulder length or longer hair are required to wear it tied back.

SCHOOL DRESS CODE SALES

- School dress code items can be purchased through the school
- P&F organise the sale of dress code items and an order form is sent out twice a year and are available at the front office.
- Sale of all items is strictly COD
- A small stock of items is also kept at school and enquiries can be made at the front office

CHANGE TO DRESS CODE ITEMS

- Any changes to the school dress code will follow the school's decision making policy, as follows:
 - P&F recommend new items
 - Recommendation taken to Principal
 - Principal takes recommendation to staff
 - Recommendation taken to Governing Council
 - Decision to be made in accordance with school decision making policy
